

Winter 2007 Tax Bill

Information for City of Frankenmuth Taxpayers

The 2007 Winter Tax Bill is enclosed for the parcels that you own. The total amount due is indicated in the upper left corner of the tax bill. The reverse side of the bill contains details showing the fiscal years and the specific taxes which are levied for Saginaw County and the Frankenmuth School District.

The tax bill is based on total mills per thousand of Taxable Value (not Assessed Value). To compute your tax, take your Taxable Value times the tax rate. The specific tax rates are indicated below:

Saginaw County	2.6791
Frankenmuth School District:	<u>3.30</u>
Total Homestead Tax	<u>5.9791</u>
Note: for Non-Homestead Parcels add 18.00 for Frankenmuth School District Operations. Total Non-Homestead Tax rate is <u>\$23.9791</u>	

There is a 1% tax administration fee charged on all tax bills.

Payment of Taxes maybe made at Frankenmuth City Hall, 240 W. Genesee, Frankenmuth, MI 48734. Our office hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. excluding holidays. For your convenience, a drive up payment drop box is in the south driveway entrance area or you may also use the letter slot in the east door of City Hall. **You may also pay your taxes at any Frankenmuth Credit Union location.** **Automatic Bill Payment Plan** is another easy method for the payment of your taxes. Please contact City Hall for information about signing up for this payment option.

If you require a receipt for your taxes, return both copies of your tax bill with your payment. If you can use your canceled check as a receipt, then return only one copy of your bill with your payment. This will save the City postage and mailing expense not sending a stamped paid receipt.

REMEMBER - Tuesday, February 14, 2008 is the final due date.

Beginning February 15, 2008, a 3% late fee becomes effective through the final payment date of February 29, 2008.

Dog Licenses for 2008 are available at City Hall from December 1, 2007 to February 29, 2008.
